

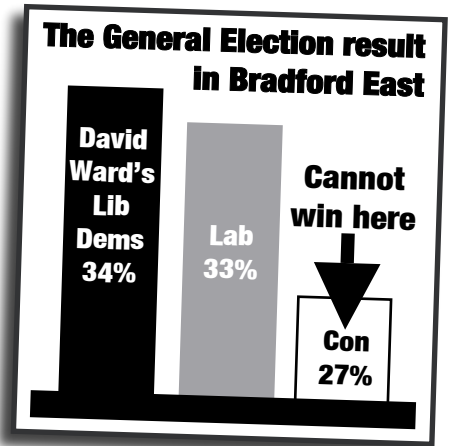

Down to Work

Newly elected Lib Dem MP David Ward has already got to work in Parliament standing up for Bradford.

In just a few months he has already publicly spoken out against changes in Education

Since May the Council has no single party with a majority. Labour and the Liberal Democrats both gained Councillors from the Conservatives leaving Labour as the largest party with 39 councillors.

The Liberal Democrats want the Council to be run by an Executive made up of Councillors from all the three main parties working together. The Labour party, under the leadership of Councillor Ian Greenwood, refuses to work with other political parties.

Lib Dem Leader Jeanette Sunderland said "Labour has the most Councillors so they have the chance to run the Council. We did not vote for this. Labour in Bradford has a poor record of sulking on the sidelines and not getting on with the job. The Conservatives have just run out of ideas.

The Lib Dems on the Council will continue to fight for the pledges we made in the election: education our top priority, protecting vulnerable people, local jobs for local people and closing the gap between rich and poor."
