**L**ocal people have contacted the Windhill and Wrose Focus Team about the planning application to use the quarry for the recycling of inert waste.

The application is detailed and supported by some substantial documentation all of which is available at [www.bradford.gov.uk](http://www.bradford.gov.uk). Follow the link for Planning.

The basic proposal is as follows:

Berry and Marshall ( Bolton Woods) Ltd, wish to recycle imported inert materials before some of it is tipped in the licensed waste disposal site at Bolton Woods Quarry. 250,000 tonnes of material will be imported each year but 60% of this will be re-exported with the aggregate from the quarry.

The company estimate that this will generate a maximum of 65 wagons per day.

At the present time there is no limit on the number of HGVs which can leave the site and the 1994 waste management licence permitted the equivalent of between 150 and 170 wagons delivering to the site.

All vehicular access is along Bolton Hall Road from the western end. There is no vehicular access from the eastern ( Wrose) end.

The operation will cause dust emissions and noise although the company say that ' the crushing and screening operation will be indiscernible from the normal quarrying operations as the site is within the quarry'.

The statement accompanying the proposal includes a list of properties which could be affected by noise.

Among those listed are Bolton Hall Road ( east ), Ridgeway, Cheltenham Grove, Claremont Grove, Livingstone Road and Kings Road.

No mention is made of the new properties in the Brookwater Drive area on the site of the former quarry. This is a serious omission and suggests a lack of knowledge of the local area.

The consultation period for this application is technically over but the Council have assured us that they will accept objections right up the point when the application is considered by the Shipley Planning Panel. The likely date of this meeting is not yet known by we will try to let people know as soon as it is announced.
