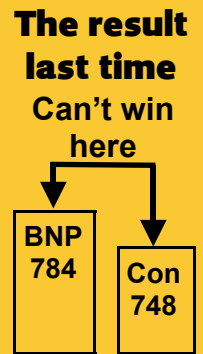

## Lib Dems win £100,000 for Windhill & Wrose

The council has come up with a plan for traffic calming to cut the speed of traffic on **Wrose Road**. It includes signs which flash when traffic is going over 30 mph, 'tables' to slow traffic down at road junctions, parking areas and right turn areas.

Cllr John Watmough held a special surgery in July and residents who came along wrote down their views about the plans.


He has discussed residents views with the council and amended plans will be presented to a special Neighbourhood Forum .

It is not too late to see the plans and comment on them so if you would like to do this please contact John as soon as possible.

**T**he Liberal Democrats on the Council have secured £100,000 for every ward in Bradford District to be spent on community projects.

Following the recent elections the Liberal Democrats agreed a work programme with the Conservatives. This included plans for making the best use of the Council's share of the money from the sale of Leeds/Bradford airport.

- ➔ Your Labour councillors did not support the sale of the airport.

The lease on Wrose Library has been extended until the end of the year but the Council has warned that if more people don't use it, then its future is not assured.

John Watmough said, " I have campaigned all along for the static library to stay open and will continue to fight to keep it open

It is a real tragedy that if your Labour councillors had agreed to join a three-party Executive to run the Council , the future of the Library would have been secure. Four Labour members and the two Liberal Democrats could have outvoted the four Conservatives on the Executive, if they had tried to close it again. "
